**On Saturday, August 10th, there will be 2 tours, one at 11 AM and the other at 2 PM.**

**On Sunday, August 11th, there will be 2 tours, one at 11 AM and the other at 2PM.**

Both tours have a high limit of 30. The students are comfortable leading a group of 20 to max 30 students and parents. When you sign up, make sure you are sure you WILL BE ABLE to attend the tour and that it is not conflicting with any contests your child is participating in.

**NorthSouth will not be responsible for your child missing the contest (any phase 1, 2 or 3) because you were on the tour or for that matter, any reason.**

Please include the total number of members who will be on the tour with you. If you won't be able to make the tour, please remove yourself so someone else will have the opportunity to go on the tour.
