Hope your children had fun learning & participating in the regional contests.

We are excited to announce the **finalists for the nationals** (both **priority 1** and **waitlist**) based on the **scores** at the regionals.

As you may be aware, the **cut-off score** is derived after consolidating the scores across all chapters, irrespective of the ranks at the regionals. Here's the link to the criteria for selection and the **cut-off scores** for the various contests:

**Registration for priority 1 and wait lists and key dates:**

- **Monday, June 2<sup>nd</sup>:** Registration for finals will open for priority 1 qualifiers and are guaranteed a spot in the finals until 8<sup>th</sup> June.
- **Monday, June 9<sup>th</sup>,** Registration opens for contestants in both priority 1 and waitlists. This will be on a first come first serve basis.
- **Saturday, June 21<sup>st</sup>:** Registration for finals for all contests closes at 11:59 PM ET or when capacity is reached.

**Contests with specific eligibility:**

Note the exceptions listed below for the eligibility for the mentioned contests. Registration for these specific contests is on a first-come-first served basis.

**Brain Bee(IBB & SBB) :** Priority will be given to students who have participated in Learning Journey Neuroscience and Brain Bee classes. If there are still some open slots, we will open it for contestants who participated in science regional contests.

**Public Speaking (PS3):** Registration is open only to those who participated in the Public Speaking regional contests. This will be on a first come first serve basis for the first 30 registrations.

**Essay Writing (EW3):** Registration is open only to those who participated in the Essay Writing regional contests. This will be on a first come first serve basis for the first 30 registrations.

**Finals date and venue:**

The finals for 2025 will be between 1<sup>st</sup>, 2nd and 3rd August at University of Texas, Dallas Richardson, TX 75080.
